RULES:

- Eligibility Dates used will be those recorded on the Bylaws Certification form issued by the Commission and attached to the approved Bylaws.
- Posts with a certification date on or after January 1*, 2019, will be automatically entered
 for the Drawing (They will not need to submit an update).
- Current, Updated or Rewritten Bylaws must be submitted in Word or PDF format to bylaws@calegion.org no later than May 1*, 2028.
- Any needed corrections identified by the Area Commissioner must have been completed and the Bylaws returned to the Area Commissioner no later than June 15°, 2028.
- The Drawing for the Prize will be at the 2028 Department of California Convention (Time and Day to be announced).
- The winning Post cannot be on Administrative Probation to win.
- Chances of winning will be determined by the number of Posts that are entered into the
 drawing with the winning ticket being drawn by Department Commander Jere Romano.

PILEASE NOTE: All Posts are required to submit their Bylaws to the Constitution and Bylaws Commission every seven years or sooner (2016 or older) for review. You can either update the ones you have or write a new set. Resources to help empower you to do this are available on the Department website at https://calegion.org/bylaws-and-resolutions/. The date is based on the approval date on the Department Approval Sheet attached to your Bylaws. Copies of your current Bylaws can be found a https://calegion.org/current.bylaws/.
