Reports are required from each post representative on the development and compliance mandates as per American Legion. Only through your oath of office in service to your membership working together as one team will we all succeed for our Veterans.










My fellow Comrades, elected and appointed Officers,

#### ONE ELECTRIC CAR BATTERY
