I've observed that processing memberships online via MyLegion.org is much more efficient, with a turnaround time of approximately 7 days. By contrast, submitting by mail to the department can take twice as long.

Lastly, be aware of email scams. The American Legion will never send vague requests like, "I'm going into a meeting, can you handle this for me?" Always check the sender's email address. If anything seems suspicious, verify by contacting the person directly using known contact details, not those provided in the questionable email.
