District 18th Vice Commander's Membership Report

Comrades,

I attempted to host a Membership Meeting on January 22nd with the 1st Vices from our District. I would like to express my gratitude to those who attended the meeting. However, as the grace period (GRACE PERIOD) comes to an end on January 31st, I will require the 1st Vices to make a concerted effort to complete the mission. We can only achieve this together, and I will be your adjutant for assistance.

It's time to focus on membership growth and ensure that our numbers reach 100% before the Convention. I want to remind everyone that the Legionaries grace period runs from January 1st to January 31st. Anyone who hasn't paid their 2026 dues by February 1st will be considered expired.

District 18th has recorded the following:

- - 36 new members
- - 296 PUFL members
- - 888 paid members
- - 5 transfers

- The total number of paid members is 1220 out of 1570, which places District 18th at 77.71% of its goal and ranks 45th in the Department of California.

Post Highlights:

- - Post 279 in Temple City has the highest percentage at 102.27%.
 - - Arcadia and Monrovia have strong performances with percentages of 93.75% and 93.75%, respectively.
 - - Post 748 in San Gabriel has a percentage of 88.89%, and Post 10 in South El Monte has a percentage of 88.57%.
 - - Post 790 in West Covina has the largest membership base with 239 paid members, accounting for 74.22% of its total.

 - Post needing attention:
 - - Post 261 in El Monte has a low percentage of 62.86%.
 - - Post 241 in Abraham Lincoln Baldwin Park has a percentage of 51.56%.
 - - Post 397 has a percentage of 69.23%, and Post 431 has a percentage of 70.00%.

 - District Totals: 77.71%

 - Membership growth is steadily increasing, but we must focus on new renewals and outreach to close the gap.

This training is highly recommended for **POST SERVICE OFFICERS**.



Immortal Four Chaplains

On February 3, 1943, the Army transport ship U.S.A.T. Dorchester was torpedoed by a submarine and sank with 902 troops on board, including the Four Immortal Chaplains. While aiding and comforting the Army troops as the ship sank, the chaplains surrendered their life jackets that others may live. As the Dorchester sank, the four chaplains linked their arms and prayed. 672 died, leaving 230 survivors.
